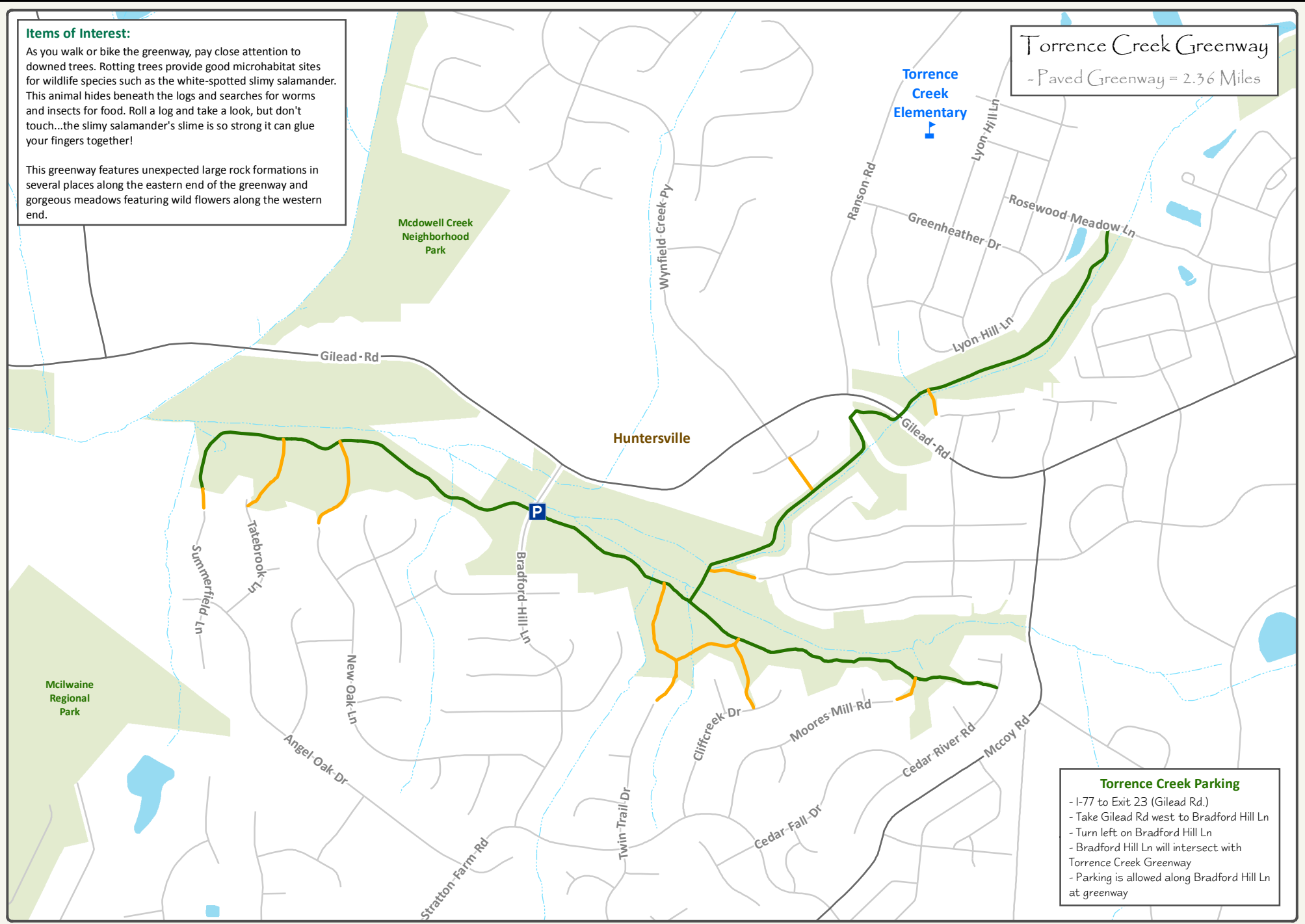


Items of Interest:

As you walk or bike the greenway, pay close attention to downed trees. Rotting trees provide good microhabitat sites for wildlife species such as the white-spotted slimy salamander. This animal hides beneath the logs and searches for worms and insects for food. Roll a log and take a look, but don't touch...the slimy salamander's slime is so strong it can glue your fingers together!

This greenway features unexpected large rock formations in several places along the eastern end of the greenway and gorgeous meadows featuring wild flowers along the western end.

Torrence Creek Greenway
- Paved Greenway = 2.36 Miles



Torrence Creek Parking

- I-77 to Exit 23 (Gilead Rd.)
- Take Gilead Rd west to Bradford Hill Ln
- Turn left on Bradford Hill Ln
- Bradford Hill Ln will intersect with Torrence Creek Greenway
- Parking is allowed along Bradford Hill Ln at greenway
